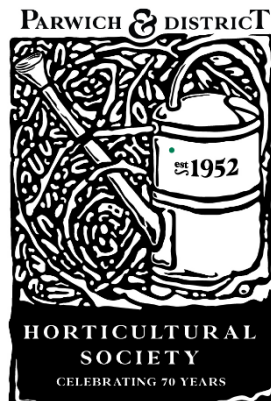


Parwich Village Show

8 Garden on a plate 8 – 11 years



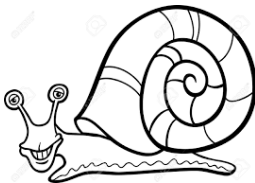
Compton-Inglesfield Junior Cup for best entry in classes 9-10

1. Entries will only be accepted if made on the official Entry Form – please complete in advance.
2. All vegetables and flowers shown must be grown in the exhibitor's own ground. This rule does not apply to the Floral Art class.
3. The Committee will take every care with each article exhibited, but will not accept any responsibility whatsoever for loss or for damage
4. All prize money will be paid out on the day of the Show.
5. Judges are appointed by the Committee and a judge's decision is final.
6. Only persons authorized to do so by the Secretary will be allowed to enter the Showroom while judging is taking place.
7. The Committee has the authority to deal with any matter not provided for in these rules.
